

TOUMBAAL PLAINS NORTHERN NSW

I recently visited Toumbaal plains, near Brooms Head, which is between Grafton and Ballina in northern NSW. It is a fascinating award-winning house with a reasonably long grass strip in a very remote location (take everything you need with you): see <http://www.toumbaalplains.com> . It sleeps 6 and is very well appointed. If you want to get around, you need to work out car hire with a company from Grafton (45 minutes drive away) or Coffs Harbour. If you had visitors from overseas, this would be great as kangaroos live in the garden and emus can be seen wandering around the property – a clearing low level pass down the runway before landing is a good idea. Brooms Head is about 5 km away and has a good general store.
